#### WHAT IS THE BOARD?

The Board of Directors is composed of Kerrisdale Community Centre Society members. You are a member of the Society if you hold a valid Kerrisdale Community Centre membership. The Board is made up of 18 elected members (nine of whom are elected each year), the past-president, and up to five additional members who may be appointed by the Board.

#### WHAT DOES THE BOARD DO?

The Board determines the budget, directs programming, sets policies regarding operations at the Centre and responds to the Park Board and other community initiatives. The Board meets on the fourth Wednesday of the month from 7:00 pm to 9:30 pm in the Centre, however due to Covid-19 meetings have moved online until further notice. A Park Board representative and staff members usually attend. Board committees report on their plans and activities at this time.

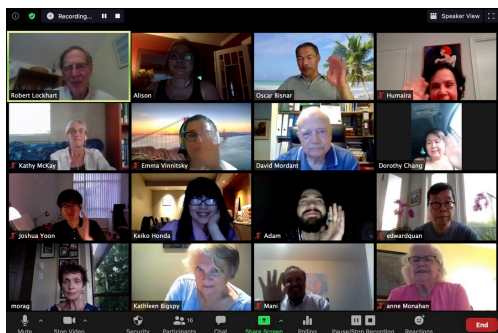
#### WHAT ARE THE COMMITTEES?
