KCCS Donations Policy

OVERVIEW

As a registered charity The Kerrisdale Community Centre Society (KCCS) may on occasion receive donations from individuals, estates, businesses other registered charities. The KCCS Donations Policy applies to all donations received by the society including but not limited to the above mentioned donors.

TYPES OF DONATIONS

Donations received and accepted by KCCS may be monetary and in-kind (supplies and services). Monetary donations are tracked and recorded on KCCS financial records. Non-monetary donations, specifically in-kind donations are not included in KCCS financial statements.

RECEIPTS AND FINANCIAL REPORTING

- All donors are entitled to receive a charitable donation tax receipt in accordance with current taxation law and the CRA guidelines.
- In compliance with CRA Requirements, KCCS issues tax receipts for all monetary donations in excess of \$20.
- Final interpretation of Revenue Canada guidelines for charitable tax receipts rests with KCCS auditors. Donors have the right to remain anonymous in accordance with provincial and federal privacy and freedom of information laws.

KCCS OBLIGATIONS TO DONORS

All donations that are received by KCCS are done so without any obligation on KCCS with respect to the donor or sponsor. In addition, a donor or sponsor may not influence the content of any KCCS program or service.

DONATION EXCLUSIONS

KCCS will not accept:

- Donations that have a stated or implied purpose of influencing KCCS program, policies or governance practices.
- Donations from a municipal, provincial, or federal political party, organizations promoting or campaigning for a political candidate or party.
- Donations from businesses or organizations whose primary purpose is the sale or promotion of tobacco, cannabis, or alcohol products.
- Donations from organizations whose purpose or activities may be deemed, at the discretion of KCCS Board of Directors to be in a conflict of interest by either the donor or KCCS.
- Donations from individuals or organizations that are contrary to KCCS mission, value and or objectives as determined by KCCS Board of Directors.
