SUBSIDY POLICY

Purpose

To set out guidelines for a program subsidy policy for the members of the Kerrisdale Community Centre Society regarding Society programs. Please note that this policy is not necessarily linked to the criteria for the City of Vancouver's Leisure Access Card.

Responsibility

To ensure that all members have access to programs regardless of their financial barriers. Each year the Finance Committee will determine the maximum amount of the subsidy to be set aside.

1. Seniors

Members 65 yrs and over are eligible for an automatic discount of 25% off the adult program price. Some programs are not eligible for subsidies such as private and semi-private lessons and satellite programs. Program supply fees are not discounted. Program fees listed in the seniors section are already subsidized.

2. Low Income

Members are eligible to apply for up to a 50% discount off the program price as long as the program minimum has been met the course will run as scheduled. Individuals are only eligible to request one subsidy per person per season. Program supply fees are not discounted. Some programs are not eligible for subsidies such as private and semi-private lessons and satellite programs. A subsidy request form must be completed and approved by a Programmer.
